



## **Fiscal Year 2025 Community Project Funding Form**

Community Project Funding allows local governments and qualified non-profits to receive a one-time, small to medium-sized federal allocation (usually \$1 million to \$5 million) to complete projects of local importance and priority. Last fiscal year, Congresswoman Boebert [secured](#) over \$20 million for 10 important water and infrastructure projects in the Third District through Community Project Funding requests that were included in House Appropriations bills and signed into law.

Any requests submitted by the Congresswoman will likely focus on major water and infrastructure projects that have a substantial impact on Colorado's Third Congressional District with a Federal Nexus. Her office is limited to 15 submissions for the entire district. However, all interested counties and eligible entities are encouraged to submit their requests by the deadline.

Community Project Funds are limited to smaller amounts, targeted to local communities. All funds will be limited to state and local governments and nonprofits that carry out quasi-government functions. For-profit institutions, such as private companies, will not be eligible for funding.

This fiscal year, "the Committee is maintaining similar [eligible program accounts](#) and [full committee guidance](#) for Fiscal Year 2025 Community Project Funding. One notable change is that non-profits are no longer eligible for Community Project Funding in the Economic Development Initiative (EDI) account."
